SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING

Thorpe Primary School received £17,770 for the 2020-21 academic year and will be using the funding in the following ways:

Use of the funding at Thorpe Primary

The money will be used to benefit **all** children regardless of their sporting ability. We will continue to place a high priority on our PE provision and have invested in additional staffing and resources to further enhance the PE curriculum and promote a healthy and active lifestyle for all. In particular the funding is used to provide:

- Subscription to membership of the local Sports UK Ltd whose coaches work within our school's partnership and who provide competitive events and tournaments which the whole partnership attends (Bradford East one Partnership of 13 schools). This year the tournaments will be held virtually due to COVID-19.
- Sports UK provide CPD for staff
- Training is provided to Year 5 pupils as play buddies, to enhance playtimes.
- Funding is used to enhance after school sports provision. School subsidises places in after-school sports clubs for all pupils who wish to participate
- Where necessary we pay for transport to and from sporting events and activities that cannot be held at our school
- Sports UK planning tools have been purchased to support whole school delivery of a skills based sports Curriculum
- Additional resources and equipment have been purchased for use at playtimes
- To increase participation of school games, a school coach will deliver extra-curricular sports provision in preparation for competitions with other local Primary Schools
- Funding towards organising, resourcing and delivering an annual Wellbeing event

At Thorpe we are committed to further improving our sports provision and as such, we monitor the impact this funding has in our school very closely. Evaluation

We will evaluate the impact of the Sports Premium funding as part of our normal self-evaluation arrangements. We will look at how well we use our Sport Premium to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sporting provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of. We aim to further increase the activity of all children in school. We will look at pupil's progress in PE as well as other areas of development such as well-being, self-esteem, confidence and the numbers of pupils involved in sporting activities in and out of school.
