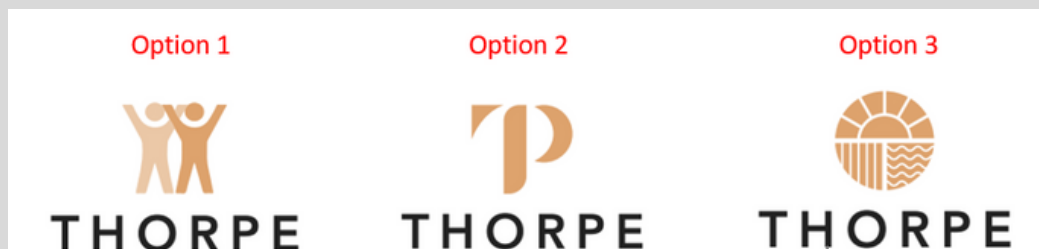
Parent's Evening
