PARENT LEARNING SHOWCASE



STRIKE ACTION

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action, which is planned to take place on several dates across February and March. The dates which have been scheduled are:

The planned strike is a consequence of national concerns relating to recruitment and retention in the profession and is not directly related to any issues at our school.

It is not yet clear what the wider impact will be for our school that day but we are working with our staff union representatives and taking guidance from the Department for Education.
