

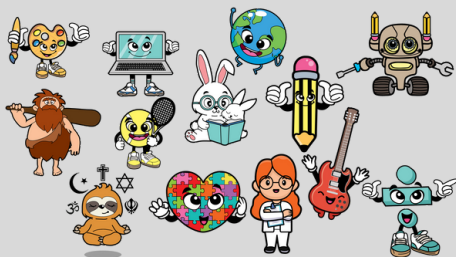

Logo Results

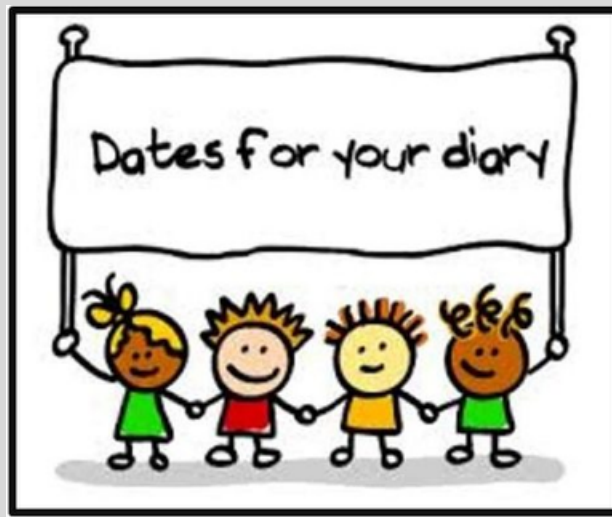
