



# THORPE PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM 2023

As you will be aware, we are updating our school uniform, effective from September 2023. You will receive one free jumper or cardigan, per child (with logo) from The Uniform Shop. You will receive a voucher for this when the shop has released the uniform. Whittaker's will also stock our uniform, however you will not be able to use the school voucher in this store. There will be other clothing with the logo, however these are not essential and plain versions are appropriate. Below, there is a guide to what will be accepted in school.

## Jumpers and Cardigans



Jumpers and cardigans will be available from The Uniform Shop (Bradford) and Whittaker's (Shipley). Jumpers and cardigans must have a logo. In the event of one off, a plain black jumper or cardigan may be accepted, however this should be approved by the Headteacher.

## Polo Tops

The school polo top must be white. It is optional whether you decide to purchase a polo top with or without the school logo. Those with the logo will be available from The Uniform Shop (Bradford) and Whittaker's (Shipley). Plain white polo tops without a logo can be purchased from a variety of different supermarkets, uniform shops or online. Price ranges vary dependent on quality and quantity.

## Trousers and Skirts



School trousers and skirts must be black. These can be purchased from a variety of different supermarkets, uniform shops or online. Price ranges vary dependent on quality and quantity. Any leggings worn must also be black, along with black socks. Children **can not** wear black jeans!

## Shoes

School shoes must be **plain black**. Plain black shoes can be purchased from a variety of different supermarkets, shoe retailers such as Clarkes, Shoe Zone and Wynsors, or online. Price ranges vary dependent on quality and design. Black trainers are not acceptable apart from P.E days.



## Pinafores and Summer Dresses



School pinafores must be black. These can be purchased from a variety of different supermarkets, uniform shops or online. Price ranges vary dependent on quality and quantity. Summer dresses can be worn during hot weather. Black is hard to find, therefore **summer dresses should be white and navy blue, not white and light blue.**

## P.E Kit



P.E kit is simplistic. Children must wear a plain white t-shirt (no logos allowed) and plain black shorts, black tracksuit bottoms (no logos allowed) or plain black leggings. For colder weather, children may wear their school jumper/ cardigan, or a plain black or grey hoodie (no logos).

## P.E Footwear

PE footwear must be **plain black**. These can be in the form of black pumps or plain black trainers (no other colours) Plain black trainers can be purchased from a variety of different supermarkets, shoe retailers such as Sports Direct, Clarkes, Shoe Zone and Wynsors, or online. Price ranges vary dependent on quality and design. Please see some examples as follows.

Black pumps cost approximately £4-£8

Non-branded black trainers can be purchased online from £10+

Branded all black trainers can also be purchased, generally for a higher price depending on brand. Please see below what is and is not acceptable in school on P.E days.



## Jewellery

For safety reasons the only jewellery allowed in school is stud earrings. Requests for exceptions may be made for religious reasons. All piercings should be taped over or removed prior to any physical activity and removed before swimming lessons by the pupil. Parents are also reminded to remove nail varnish from their children's finger nails before arriving at school. Longhair: Children with long hair must tie their hair back for practical activities such as PE and baking. Extreme hairstyles, shaving patterns and colouring are not part of our uniform policy.
